

HOW TO THROW A LOUD SHIRT DAY PARTY!

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FIND YOUR SHIRT!

The sixties, seventies and eighties gave us some seriously loud prints. Head to your local Salvos, St Vinnies or an opportunity shop within your community. Don't be shy to check both the ladies and gents section. Think outside the box too! Found tons of chunky costume jewellery but no bold prints? Customise a regular tee by sewing the corners of the necklaces to the neckline of the shirt.

DIY YOUR BUNTING

Your local Spotlight or fabric store will have tons of pre-cut pieces of material just begging to be made into shirt bunting! Cut a basic shirt shape out of cardboard to use as your stencil. Then trace onto your bold fabrics. Once they're cut, use little pegs to hang it to your 'clothesline' and string it over your party table!

PLAN YOUR PARTY TABLE

Let's not be subtle now! Start with a bold tablecloth and then layer it with your brightest party ware. Think fruit shaped paper plates, gold plastic cutlery and patterned napkins. For a *little* cohesion, stick to mostly one colour palette. If you love gold add yellow, red, pink and orange. More a silver type? Embrace blues, purples and greens.

MAKE A PINATA PIGGY BANK
