Week 9 4 May	<p>Language Development Strategies Listening and Spoken Language Specialist This week is all about strategies you can incorporate into your everyday life to help your child develop language.</p>
Week 10 11 May	<p>Social and Emotional Development & Resilience in children Child and Family Counsellor This week focuses on the social and emotional development of your child – it's not just about ears and hearing.</p>
Week 11 18 May	<p>Audiology Tests for my child & Ear Health Audiologist There are a range of different hearing tests your child may have over time. This topic is all about making sense of those tests. We will also touch on what happens when children have middle ear infections and when you should seek medical advice from your GP or an ENT.</p>
Week 12 25 May	<p>Clear Speech and the role of listening in this Listening and Spoken Language Specialist The week we will explore how children learn to speak, when to be concerned and simple strategies you can incorporate into your everyday life to help your child to develop clear speech.</p>
Week 13 1 June	<p>Guest Panel For Your Questions Your Child And Family Counsellor will be joined by another Shepherd Centre parent, a Listening and Spoken Language Specialist and a Paediatric Audiologist in a session dedicated to answering questions from the group. Week 14 8 June	<p>Everyday routines: children learn every minute Listening and Spoken Language Specialist Children are constantly learning. This topic is all about taking advantage of everyday routines to build your child's listening, language, speech and social skills.</p>
Week 15 15 June	<p>Knowing Your Child Is On Track Child and Family Counsellor and Listening and Spoken Language Specialist How do you know if your child is on track with their development? This week we explore typical development and how it is assessed.</p>
Week 16 22 June	<p>Getting the right plans in place Child and Family Counsellor This topic talks about Individual Family Service Plans (IFSPs), as well as funding options available to support your family.</p>
